Learning Objectives:

Students will use their five senses to make observations. Students will learn how animals use their sense to survive and grow in their habitats.

Description:

In this program, a WCS educator will lead your students on an exploration of the five senses that animals use to interact with the world. Your class will meet an animal, learn about the different senses, and gain an understanding of how animals use their senses for survival.

- Generate appropriate questions and predictions in response to observations
