Group Sales Policies

- Student rates are only applicable for students in grades K–12.
- All group ticket orders receive one (1) complimentary ticket per 20 tickets purchased.
- Student groups require one (1) adult chaperone for every 10 minors. Chaperones must remain with their group at all times.
- Full payment is due 2 weeks before the scheduled visit date to receive the group rate; otherwise regular rates or additional fees may apply.
- Ticket prices valid through the 2026 season.

Spring and Summer


- **Daniel Tiger’s Neighborhood at the Bronx Zoo** —The beloved PBS KIDS series from Fred Rogers Productions comes to the Bronx Zoo from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day, 2026! With the world premiere of this all-new experience, your group can spend a day at the zoo with your favorite characters. Explore an interactive exhibit with activities, photo ops, a live theatrical performance followed by a meet & greet, and more! *Included with all tickets.*
- **World of Darkness** — Step into the dark inside the Bronx Zoo’s newest exhibit and discover the mysteries, adaptations, and surprises of animals that thrive in darkness.
- Journey into the heart of the Asian wilderness aboard the *Wild Asia Monorail* and spot elephants, rhinos, tigers, and other species.
- Discover the rainforests of Africa in *Congo Gorilla Forest*—learn about their unique personalities and behavior of our western lowland gorillas.
- At the *Children’s Zoo*, meet prairie dogs, Caribbean flamingos, a giant anteater, and playful squirrel monkeys, and more.

Fall

- Spend an autumn day outdoors, wandering through tree-line pathways bursting in color.
- Say hello to the California sea lions at the *Sea Lion Pool* (feedings daily at 3pm!).
- Learn how the American bison were saved from extinction, while watching them roam along the Bronx River.
- Visit gelada baboons, Nubian ibex, and rock hyrax at the *Gelada Reserve*.

Winter

- The park’s hardwood forest transforms into a winter wonderland.
- Come face to face with an Amur tiger, the world’s largest cat, at *Tiger Mountain*.
- Watch the grizzly bears play together, wrestling and rolling around in the snow at the *Big Bears* exhibit.
- Catch a glimpse of the mysterious snow leopards playing together at the *Himalayan Highlands*.
- Warm up inside at *Jungleworld*, where you can spot a tree kangaroo, otters, and ebony langurs hanging out in the branches.



New York Aquarium



At New York City's only aquarium, your group can take a deep dive into the ocean and encounter more than 5,000 amazing aquatic animals.

- Meet bizarre but breathtaking invertebrates in *Spineless*. Encounter the world's largest living arthropod—the Japanese spider crab—and the tiny flamboyant cuttlefish.
- At *Ocean Wonders: Sharks!*, walk through a tunnel of colorful coral reefs while sharks and butterfly fish swim around you. Learn fun facts about how to protect the sharks, whales, and other marine animals found in New York's waters.
- *Sea Change* offers intimate underwater views of sea lions, penguins, harbor seals, and sea otters.
- Hang out with penguins, sea otters, sea lions, and harbor seals along the rocky shores of the *Sea Cliffs* exhibit.
- At the *Aquatheater*, learn about sea lions, and witness the incredible bonds they have with their keepers.
- At *PlayQuarium*, elementary-aged kids can transform into sharks, sardines, and humpback whales while they explore the ocean.

Central Park Zoo Prospect Park Zoo Queens Zoo

If you're in NYC, there's a WCS park right in your neighborhood. Central Park Zoo, Prospect Park Zoo, and Queens Zoo offer incredible animal experiences for your whole group.

Central Park Zoo

- Explore 7.5 gorgeous acres of an iconic park and discover majestic wildlife in the heart of Manhattan
- Encounter tropical birds, snow leopards, harbor seals, and one of the nation's largest colonies of Antarctic penguins

Queens Zoo

- Explore 20 acres of beautiful outdoor exhibits
- Encounter wildlife native to the Americas in the heart of Queens, including southern pudu from Chile and Argentina, American bison from the Great Plains, and Andean bears—the only South American bear species

Prospect Park Zoo

- Explore a 9-acre zoo in Prospect Park, home to almost 600 animals
- Designed to allow up-close animal viewing, perfect for young children who want to learn about wildlife
- Encounter dingos, red pandas, and the elusive Pallas's cat (aka the original grumpy cat). Pet and feed alpacas, sheep, and zebu
